<i>Weigh-In:</i>	Saturday - 8am – 9am (Reweighs only 9am – 9.30am) Sunday - 8am – 9am (Reweighs only 9am – 9.30am)
<i>Registration/ Kit Check</i>	Lifters are encouraged to have their equipment checked prior to weigh-in. However, there will also be registration & kit check on Saturday & Sunday morning's during weigh-in times.
<i>Entry Fees:</i>	€85 for first Entry €30 for an additional Entry As per the WDFPF regulations, each nation will be liable to pay the event organisers 50% of the entry fee for all lifters entered who fail to compete.
<i>To Enter:</i>	All lifters must submit their entry forms & entry fees to their National Federation for inclusion on the National Team List. This list must be sent or e-mailed by the National Federation to by the closing date.

	<p>Entries from lifters not included on the Team list cannot be accepted. The entry fees for the whole national team must be paid at registration by a representative of that nation.</p> <p>The event is run by qualification & invitation only.</p>
<i>Closing Date:</i>	<p>All national team lists must reach their organisers by 07/04/2025. National Federations will need to set an earlier closing date to ensure they receive all entries prior to submitting them to the organiser by the 11/04/2025. The entry forms & release from liability signed by the lifters must be handed in at registration.</p>
<i>Reception:</i>	<p>There will be a reception for all lifters & officials on Friday from 7-9pm at the Old Coach Inn.</p>
<i>Celebration Party:</i>	<p>A celebration function will be held on the Sunday night. Further details will be confirmed closer to the event.</p>
<i>Hotels</i>	<p>The Glencarn Hotel will be the designated hotel for this event. The Hotel has a leisure centre including a fitness suite. The hotel is located in the town centre. There are many other accommodation options available.</p>
